

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT Town of Sumner

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 10 days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot.

TO OBTAIN AN ABSENTEE BALLOT YOU MUST MAKE A REQUEST IN WRITING.

Contact the Town Clerk at 608-884-7925 and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the **SPRING NON PARTISAN GENERAL ELECTION on TUESDAY, APRIL 02, 2013**. You may also request an absentee ballot by letter. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature.

Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the Clerk at 608-884-7925.

You can also personally go to the clerk's office at the Sumner Town Hall, complete a written application, and vote an absentee ballot during the hours specified for casting an absentee ballot.

THE DEADLINE FOR making application to vote absentee by mail is 5:00 p.m., on THURSDAY, MARCH 28 2013.

(Military electors should contact the clerk at 608-884-7925 regarding the deadlines for requesting or submitting an absentee ballot.)

THE FIRST DAY TO vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is MONDAY, MARCH 11, 2013.

THE DEADLINE for voting an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is at 5:00PM on Friday before the election, MARCH 29, 2013.

The municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before election day to the proper polling place or counting location before the polls close on TUESDAY, APRIL 02, 2013 any ballots received after the polls close will be counted by the board of canvassers if postmarked by election day and received no later than 4:00 p.m. on FRIDAY, APRIL 5, 2013 following the election.
