

**TOWN OF SUMNER
ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE CLASS “B” HIGHWAYS
ORDINANCE # C200-2010-1009**

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Sumner
Jefferson County, WI

The Town Board of the Town of Sumner, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.15 (2), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates all town highways as Class “B” highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of Sumner are designated class “B” highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s 348.16 (2), Wis. Stats., unless increased by town ordinance: SEE ADDENDUM #1 (Road List).
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. Stats. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s 348.21, Wis. Stats.
- D. **PERMIT** to authorize travel by an overweight vehicle travel on Town of Sumner highways may be issued under Town of Sumner Permit #PFOV20100913, titled “Permit for Overweight Vehicles”. Permit shall be applied for in writing. Permits may be issued by the Town Board at a regular scheduled Town Board meeting and may be issued on occasional basis for a non routine load where no other alternative exists.
- E. **PENALTY** for Violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be forfeiture as provided under Wis. Stats. 348.16 together with the costs of prosecution
- F. **SEVERABILITY** – If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.
- G. **ENFORCEMENT** – This ordinance may be enforced by the issuance of a citation by officials or designees of officials authorized to issue overweight limit citations.

This ordinance is effective on publication _____, ____, 2010.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s 60.80, Wis. Stats.
