

ORDINANCE # 54

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE SECTION
AS A MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE
TOWN OF SUMNER
PLAN COMMISSION ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

The Town Board of the Town of Sumner, Jefferson, Wisconsin, do hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The municipal code of the Town of Sumner is hereby created to read as follows:

PLAN COMMISSION ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

(1) There is hereby created a Plan Commission Administrative Fee, the amount of which shall be set from time to time by Resolution of the Town Board.

(2) The purpose of the Plan Commission Administrative Fee shall be to reimburse the administrative expenses of the Plan Commission survey map approvals, conditional use permits, and other matters which may come before the Plan Commission.

(3) No matter shall be considered by the Plan Commission until the administrative fee shall have been paid to the Town Clerk and satisfactory evidence of receipt of that fee shall be presented to the Plan Commission.

(4) This administrative fee shall be in addition to and separate from any payments required from applicants for professional fees or consideration for action upon any matters which come before the Plan Commission. Such fee shall be paid to the Town of Sumner at such time as the submission of the petition and shall be non-refundable.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not thereof the ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
