**Subject: Flooding conditions in the Town of Sumner**

**1. Black Island Road**

- a. Minor flooding in this area as follows:

At W7598 and south of this location River water approximately 2 feet from the road edge. At the end of the Island at pier location water on the road approximately 4 to 4 feet. W7485 River over the bank and flooding land area. W7342 on the river side is minor flooding at the Lorraine Niedecker property.

**2. North Shore area**

- a. Field flooding at the North East and South East corner of Burhnam and North Shore Road.  
No property in jeopardy at this time.
- b. At W 7693 minor flooding occurring from the non lake side of the Lamp Road.  
No properties affected at this time.

**3. Other**

The rest of the Town of Sumner is wet and some agricultural land in low areas have some minor flooding conditions. The water levels on the Lake Koshkonong and the Rock River are above normal and at minor flood stage. National Weather Service has the Koshkonong Lake area under flood warning which would affect Blackhawk Island Road from now through Saturday the 19<sup>th</sup> of May. Town official will continue to monitor conditions. Residents within the Blackhawk Island area are advised to take action as necessary to protect their personal property.
